

The California Business Roundtable strongly supports community colleges – but Proposition 92 will cause more problems than it claims to solve.

Proposition 92 would amend California's constitution to lock in a huge new state spending mandate – with no way to pay for it. The California Legislative Analyst's Office estimates the increased spending will reach nearly a billion dollars in the first three years. The legislature would be left to decide how to fund the measure. They could raise taxes or they could cut other critical programs like health care, public safety, transportation and education funding, including K-12, and state universities.

Proposition 92 expands bureaucracy, but contains no accountability or independent oversight, and requires no public audits. There will be no way to know how the Prop. 92 money is spent and no guarantee one cent of the new money will help students.
